

2025 Budget Highlights

Our church budget is funded solely through contributions from our members and friends. Each year we use this money to further God's mission both within the church and beyond our walls. And each year the leadership in the church evaluates the goals and priorities of our church community and makes changes to our spending and fundraising goals.

Here are some highlights of those priorities for 2025:

- Personnel: Support our staff to empower the ministries and people of the church through worship, leading, service and learning. Plan for our new Associate Pastor.
- Mission: Work in our community with neighbors experiencing homelessness and hunger through our partnership with FACETS, and globally through our long-standing partnerships in Kibwezi and Malawi.
- Spiritual Growth for Adults, Youth, and Children: Nurture and walk alongside children and youth in Rainbow, Godly Play, VBS, Sunday School, IMPACT, Youth Connections, and College Ministries. Provide opportunities for adults to connect and deepen in their learning during Sunday School, small groups, and guest speakers.
- **Congregational Care:** Connect with one another through picnics, potlucks, intergenerational Sunday School, and conversations over coffee after worship.
- **Facilities:** Keep the lights and heat on, make sure all visitors have safe access to our church, maintain and improve our building.
- **Worship:** Support the people and technology that connect those worshiping from home, with those in the Meeting House.
